

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

Burning is prohibited by City Ordinance

LOVELAND, OHIO - The City of Loveland's annual fall leaf collection has begun.

Residents should rake leaves to a place near the street or curb. The City says, "Do not place leaf piles on the sidewalk, gutters, or roads." After the regular pickup schedule is complete, all leaves must be disposed of by being placed in containers at the curb for regular trash collection or composted in a bin. The schedule calls for each neighborhood to have two collection periods. Residents are requested to have leaves at the curb on the beginning date of the scheduled pick-up period in the following neighborhoods:
