Miles</u></p>		<p>PROPOSED TAX LEVY (RENEWAL) DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES SERVICES CLERMONT COUNTY</p> <p>A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.</p> <p>A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Clermont County, Ohio, for the purpose of the operation of the County Board of Developmental Disabilities programs and services and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance, and operation of mental retardation and developmental disabilities facilities by the County Board of Developmental Disabilities at a rate not exceeding seventy-five hundredths (0.75) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to seven and one-half cents (\$0.075) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2013, first due in calendar year 2014.</p>
