

LOVELAND, OHIO - Loveland Initiative 2007 Backpack Program

LOVELAND, OHIO - "If you can donate one of these filled Backpacks the children appreciate it more than you can imagine, " said Terri Rogers, President of the Loveland Initiative. "If you are not able to complete an entire backpack by yourself, perhaps you can share this project with a friend."

Rogers is also asking the community to donate school supplies such as paper, pencils, rulers, etc., so the Initiative can have these in stock throughout the school year.

The bags and supplies should be for school age children from preschool through the 12th grade.

- 1 backpack
- 1 subject notebooks (paper) /three prong pocket folders
- 12 packs wide rule (8-1/2"X 11")
- 16 pencils (unsharpened), pencil bags (older)
- 1 pencil boxes (smaller kids)
- 11 ruler (metric and inches), protractor & compass
- 11 pair of scissors, pens (blue, black, red)
- 11 package of construction paper
- 11 box of markers (8 to set) & 1 box of crayons (24 to set)
- 11 eraser or pack of pencil tip erasers
- 13 glue sticks, note cards, color pencils
- 11 pencil sharpener, tab dividers, graph paper
- 1 stretch book covers, composition books
- 11 inch & 3 inch binders
- 1 highlighters (yellow)
- 1 kleenex tissue

Make sure the bag is age appropriate. For example, if preparing backpack for a younger child, buy wide ruled paper, blunt tip scissors, etc. Label bag as "younger or older".

Rogers said she would like to have the bags by Friday August 17th, 2007, to be distributed on Monday August 20 at the Loveland Initiative Center.
